I realise the new news about restrictions would have come as a huge disappointment to many, and for those not able to see family, especially hard this year.

There have been changes for church services due to us being on the border of tier 4 and we are particularly affected because so many from our congregations are in tier 4 areas.

Tier 4 people have a stay at home order. Travel in and out of tier 4 is not advised. This means that travelling to services with us from tier 4 is not advised. We will continue however to support you online with services.

If you cannot come to any of our Christmas services you signed up to (e.g. you are isolating, have symptoms, can't travel) please, if you can, take a moment to cancel, as it helps with planning and spaces are limited. There is an option to cancel on the email you got.
