Giving in Lockdown

• Telephone/online - Parish Giving Scheme: The best way to give regularly

Sign up (or adjust you existing giving) with the Parish Giving Scheme (details on that below). This is set up with the Church of England's national scheme and does not include fees for our church to pay. Gift aid if you can, so we can reclaim tax.
